**Language notes:** Most records are in English, except *Az Otthon* material, which is in Hungarian.

**Other formats:** Microfilm copy of some records available (microfilm reference number R.10).

**Finding aids:** Original files and series listed in GS-168, section A.676.XVII.A. Microfilm contents listed in IR-12.
