Biography: Herman Milton Austenson was born and raised on a farm in Viscount, Saskatchewan. He attended both the University of Saskatchewan (earning a BSA in 1946 and his MSc in 1948) and Washington State University (where he earned a PhD in 1951). After 14 years on the faculties of Cornell University and Washington State University, he returned to the University of Saskatchewan in 1966. From 1975 to 1983 he served as head of the department of Crop Science and Director of the Crop Development Centre. During this time the plant breeding work at the University of Saskatchewan made considerable progress and its variety testing work was extended throughout the province. Dr. Austenson's own research activities included the areas of pasture management, seed quality and cereal agronomy. He died in Saskatoon on 29 March 1997.

**Scope and Content:** This fonds contains correspondence, reports, publications and memoranda relating to the research activities of Herman Austenson, as well as some administrative records relating to the department of Crop Science and Plant Ecology, and the research activities of the Crop Development Centre. Some of the materials were created by JB Harrington; these files have been identified whenever possible.

### Series I: CANADIAN SOCIETY OF AGRONOMY. - 20 cm. of textual records.

Pioneer workers with field crops and soils in the prairie provinces organized the Western Canadian Society of Agronomy at a two day meeting held in Saskatoon, 29-30 December 1919. John Bracken was elected first president; the objective of the Society was 'to encourage investigational work in crops and soils and to disseminate the results obtained.' Although academic qualifications were not a requirement of membership, several University of Saskatchewan professors were active members, including JB Harrington and LE Kirk. The depression of the 1930s and WWII adversely affected the Society, which disbanded in 1947. In 1953, a nationwide society was formed: the Canadian Society of Agronomy (CSA).
