Reading through the journal one can conclude that their children were Rella and Ronald. Ronald worked on the farm. Rella was a teacher at Alexandra School in Moose Jaw. J.H. Brubaker was a grain farmer, he also owned livestock. It appears he did his business in Moose Jaw and attended a Protestant church on Sundays.
