Box 1

Series 1: General Print Blocks

1. 5 print blocks.

Four blocks appear to have been used in the production of the Normal School yearbook "*The Light*", and one of which is a map of campus used in the 1909-1910 President's report.

All blocks look to have been produced by the same printing company, at this time unknown. (possibly Elliott Printers of Saskatoon?)

2. Photo Print Block purportedly of Reverend Maximchuck and his wife – see also the Maximchuk collection of books in Cyrillic.

3. Various Saskatoon Print Blocks.

From a number of local businesses such as Early's, Marketmall, and Jubilee Ford, as well as larger businesses such as CAA, Eatons, and even Canada Post..
