**Biography:** Wanda Ena Young was born on 4 January 1923 in Park River, North Dakota. She attended High School in Waseca, Saskatchewan before coming to the University of Saskatchewan, where she received a BEd in 1943. Young continued her education at the University of Alberta (BEd, 1947) and Columbia University (MA, 1956). Young joined the faculty of the University of Saskatchewan in 1968 as an assistant professor. During her career, Young served as president of the Canadian Home Economics Association, and on the executive committee of the International Federation of Home Economics.
