This Stoney Lake Day will give the public a chance to look over the information and draw their own conclusions. The various groups involved in the project have compiled some of the different data and will display it to the public.

The displays on hand will be many and varied. These displays will include such things as a microscopic look or a drink (if you wish) of authentic Stoney Lake water. This sample would be provided by the water analysis group for you to analyze. Another group will provide topographic maps of the region around Humboldt, including the sewage lagoon, drainage patterns and Stoney Lake itself. Letters and information from the archives in Saskatoon have been collected and will be on display. Historical photos will give one an idea of the lake's not so distant past. Films, slides and video-tape will show group members at work and a look at the region of Stoney Lake seldom seen. This will give the public the opportunity to see the operation and responsibilities of each group within the project as well as giving a first hand view of the lake's condition and future potential.

A public opinion poll is also planned as part of Stoney Lake Day. This poll will provide the public with the opportunity to express their views on Stoney Lake conditions.

This Stoney Lake Day will be a preliminary look at this situation. The groups hope to be able to publish their final results and present them to the public as well as Town Council and the Department of the Environment.

Stoney Lake is a non-renewable resource and there has been many outcries for retaining such resources. The lake itself is a complex ecosystem and many macroorganisms as well as microscopic organisms depend on this relatively small area.

If there is a problem the people should be made aware. We believe by our Stoney Lake Day we can present the facts to you. After that, it is up to you to decide. So we hope you will make a note, take the afternoon off and see the many displays at Stoney Lake Day.
