His ideas rest not only on a change of scale. but require a change in attitude toward life and what it has offer. The decision for the developed world get along with fewer. but more durable and environmentally sound consumer goods, would greatly aid the redistribution of global wealth.

The implication Schumacher's plan would involve conservation and restraint. but whatever we lose in the way of consumer goods, we would gain back in our renewed sense of self and relationship with the rest of the planet.




