## CRESCENT PARK FOUNDATION INC.

Crescent Park Foundation Inc. was created in 1971 by the initiative of the late Dr. Gerald Parkins and the late Mr. Geoff Hawkins. In consultation with mutual friends, they developed the concept of establishing a Fund; the income of which was to be used for enhancing the amenities of Crescent Park.

The ideas developed by Dr. Parkins, Mr. Hawkins, and their friends are contained in a memorandum dated January 1971, a copy of which is shown as Appendix 1. Dr. Parkins' memorandum formed the basis for drafting a Constitution and, on June 21<sup>st</sup>, 1971, the Foundation was registered under the former Societies' Act of the Province of Saskatchewan. As a result of legislative changes, the Foundation was continued as a Not-For-Profit Corporation under the name
